Bracknell Forest Multi-agency Risk Framework





Local Authority Safeguarding Duties:

- an adult (18+) who:
- has needs for care and support (whether or not the local authority is meeting any of those needs)
- is experiencing, or at risk of, abuse or neglect
- as a result of those care and support needs is unable to protect themselves from either the risk of, or the experience of abuse or neglect

- During the Covid period there has been greater awareness and visibility of adults in the community whose circumstances do not 'fit' with Care Act safeguarding criteria but about whom there are shared agency concerns
- This has been due to the 'stopping' of things like employment, chances to meet and get together, community activities, church activities etc.

Adult A Issues and Outcomes:

- ISSUES
- Furloughed
- Loss of routine affected drinking management
- Accommodation breakdown with parents led to rough sleeping, selfneglect, anti-social behaviour, regular calls to emergency services
- Risk of criminal charges.

OUTCOMES

- Risk Framework Tool completed with adult A and parents. Agencies included Rough Sleeper Team, TVP, Housing team, DAAT team, Social Worker Adult Community Team, The Community Safety.
- Identified key people to work with Adult A.
- Accommodation resolved
- Improved engagement with GP and DAAT team
- Parents found to need support from Adult Social Care
- Risks reduced for Adult A and for his parents
- Agencies have a plan and ongoing collaboration established
