

What is Healthwatch?

Healthwatch is your health and social care champion. We make sure NHS leaders and other decision makers hear your voice and use your feedback to improve care.



Healthwatch was established by the government under the, <u>Health and Social Care Act 2012</u>

It was established to help understand the needs, experiences and concerns of people who use health and social care services and to speak out on their behalf.

Healthwatch is a statutory independent organisation. Every council in England must commission a local Healthwatch service



The role of local Healthwatch

Local Healthwatch service functions:

Obtain the views of people about their needs and experience of local health and social care services. Make these views known to those involved in the commissioning and scrutiny of care services.

- Provide information and advice and signposting to the public about health and social care services, council services and voluntary, community services.
- Provide local Care Quality Commission (CQC) with any concerns about health, social care and care home services.
- Carry out the 'Enter and View' function. It is not an inspection. Visit health and care services (including care homes) to collect evidence and report on what works well and what could be improved





What do we do and how do we do it?

If you use GPs and hospitals, dentists, pharmacies, care homes or other support services, we want to hear about your experiences.

As an independent statutory body, we have the power to make sure NHS leaders and other decision makers listen to your feedback and improve standards of care. We can also help you to find reliable and trustworthy information and advice. Last year, Healthwatch helped nearly a million people like you to have your say and get the support you need.

GP Access survey:

Healthwatch staff investigated 83 Frimley Healthcare GP Surgery websites and their subsequent recommendations led to an immediate redesigning to a much more user friendly and accessible website. It will be relaunched across 56 surgeries.
